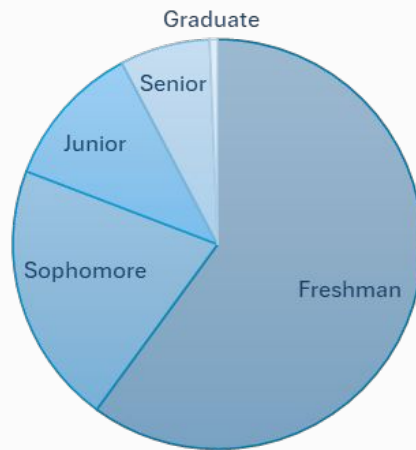

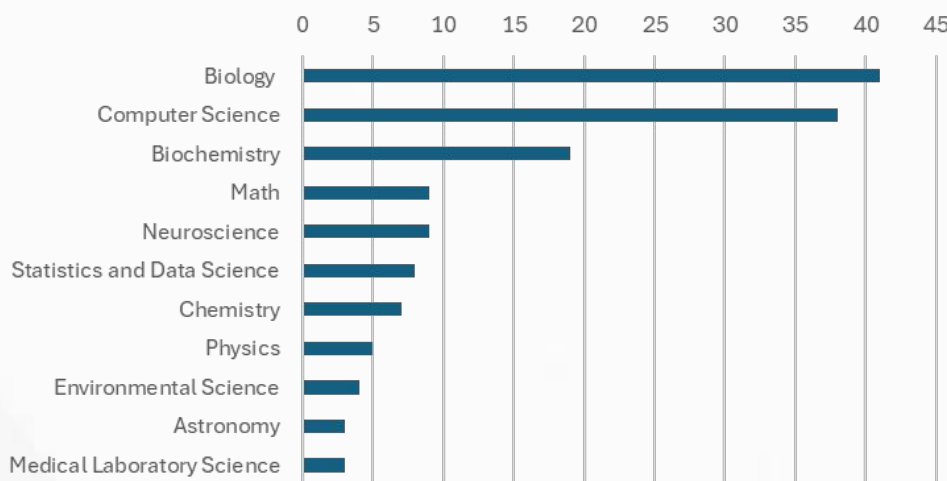

Members with College of Natural Science Majors



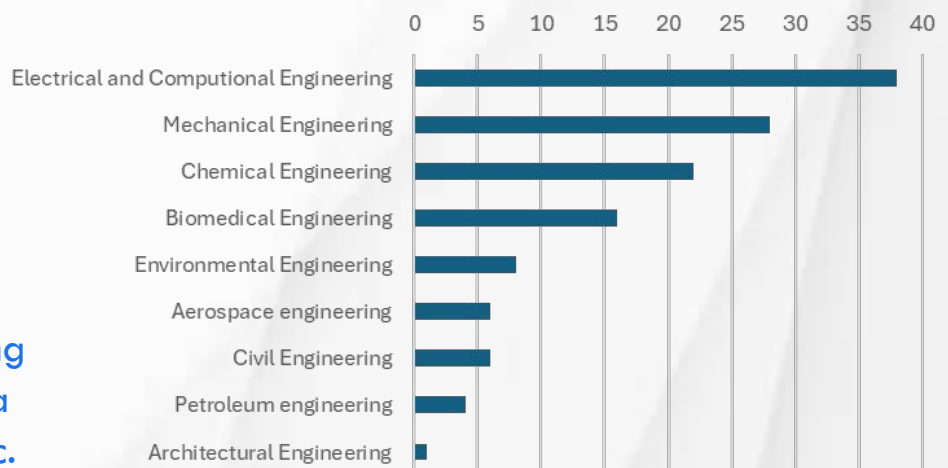
